

# **NOTICE OF TAX REVENUE INCREASE**

Brazos County conducted public hearings on September 6, 2011 and September 13, 2011 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the Brazos County from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 3.03 percent.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.4856 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$49,902,387.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.485000 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$50,129,834.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.485000 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$51,593,092.

The Brazos County Commissioners Court of Brazos County is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on September 20, 2011 at the Commissioners' Courtroom, Suite 106, County Administration Bldg., 200 S Texas Avenue, Bryan, Texas at 4:00 PM.
